Jim Wolf Begins New Term on Grand Council

Jim Wolf, Alpha Delta '79, has been appointed to Grand Council from the list of chapter nominations received last Spring. He replaces Ken Kubiak, Theta '76, who served his second year while in graduate studies at Rensselaer.

Two of the ten positions on the Grand Council are occupied by active chapter members who are expected to help shape national policies and allocate our budget resources to various programs. They attend three to four Council meetings per year and are encouraged to visit as many chapters as possible in order to represent active member view points. Jim joins Thad Throneburg, Alpha-Alpha '78, who is beginning the second year of his term.

As a finance major with a 3.85 overall grade average, Jim has been elected into the Phi Eta Sigma honorary society and was the recipient of the President's Freshman Award for Academic Achievement. He was chosen as one of six members of a I.F.C. Planning Committee from a field of nominations from fifty fraternities.

Within his chapter, Jim has been active in intramural sports and served as spring rush chairman—the result of which was the largest fall pledge class in a number of years.


Four Alumni are Recognized For Distinguished Service

Congress is traditionally the time when special recognition is given to one or more alumni who have distinguished themselves in service to their chapter or the Fraternity as a whole. Nominations are submitted by chapter and alumni associations to point out outstanding achievements or recognize long periods of above average service.

After reviewing the list of nominees submitted, the Grand Council felt that failure to recognize any one of four alumni would have been an injustice to those not chosen. There is no set number which is fixed for this distinguished award. This past year's alumni who were chosen were: William Kitchin, Alpha '49; John M. Foushee, Alpha-Alpha '26; William Coppedge, Iota Delta '75; and John Craft, Iota Delta '61.

Bill Kitchin's efforts to regroup a dormant association for his chapter and achieve substantial improvements to an aging chapter house deserves his selection. It must be noted that at least six other alumni of Alpha Chapter were instrumental in the achievements of that association.

John Foushee was a charter member of the recolonization of this founding chapter of our Southern Order. Eleven years later, he was among the group

which succeeded in buying the present chapter house and is still treasurer of the alumni association today. Few chapters can match the years of solid money management which has been achieved through the cooperative effort of actives and interested, competent alumni.

Brad Coppedge and John Craft were instrumental in a major and successful rush effort for their chapter during the Spring of 1977. Their personal involvement coupled with the work of the active chapter led to the most successful rush campaign since the early seventies.

It is noteworthy that eleven other alumni who contributed greatly to their chapters were not selected for the special recognition. This is a credit to alumni involvement which is one reason for the chapter improvement seen in the past few years.

Congress Shines In Spite of Weather In Miami Beach


65 Delegates from 36 Chapters

Florida sunshine greeted the early arriving delegates and alumni at this year's Chi Phi Congress and Leadership Seminar held at the beautiful Americana Hotel on Miami Beach. Sixty-five delegates from thirty-six chapters plus a large number of alumni were present for the week's activities. As things would have it, only those early arrivers were able to get their share of sunshine. The weather turned cloudy and rainy until after the close of Congress. However, in true Chi Phi tradition, a little rain didn't dampen the spirit or "spirits" of the week.

The delegates gathered on Wednesday, August 10th for the beginning of the two-day Leadership Seminar sponsored by the Chi Phi Educational Trust. The workshop was coordinated and conducted by our National Director, Ray Donohue and Assistant, Harley Schoenfeldt both of whom led specific aspects of the seminar. The highlight of the program was the business management session conducted by Dr. Daniel Steinhoff, Beta Delta '34, who currently is a professor in the Business Department at the University of Miami. His last Chi Phi Congress was as a delegate in 1933. Other aspects of the program concentrated on an overview of Fraternity and Trust organization, pledge education, and an open panel question and answer session consisting of four members of the Grand Council.





scheduled at the chapter house. If there was ever a reason for a road trip, this is surely one. It is also a great opportunity for alumni to spend a few hours reliving some old times.



Bob Cody Conducts Legislative Session

Congress itself was gavelled to order at 9:00 A.M. Friday by Grand Alpha, Darryl McCall who led the program's initial business until Brother Robert S. Cody, Theta Delta '40, was elected Alpha of Congress. Bob's legislative skills directed the delegates through the remaining two and a half days to one of the smoothest conventions our Fraternity has experienced. Five committees were assigned to consider proposals and report recommendations to the convention floor for vote of all delegates. Major legislation and funding provisions enacted include:

1. Changing the Fraternity fiscal year to June 30 which will allow more time for preparation of data prior to conventions.

2. Approval of the 1977-78 budget which includes funding for an additional staff employee, increased chapter visitation program and funding for computer alumni record system as major items.

3. Giving Greek letter titles to both undergraduate members of Council to increase their stature and image. Grand Theta and Iota are the new designations.

4. Adoption of Sturgis Rules of Parliamentary Procedures to replace Robert's Rules of Order.

5. Selection of Birmingham, Alabama as the site of the 1978 Congress with requests of alumni bids for the 1979 convention to be considered by delegates of our next Congress.


The previous year's Congress was

characterized by Grand Alpha, Darryl McCall's "New Day" program with its long hours of debate concerning the funding method of the chapter special assessment. The decisions made were apparently correct in that this Congress saw no proposals or debate to recall the issue or modify the load shared equally by all actives this past year.

One important aspect of this year's Congress was the emphasis placed on our ritual. All our ceremonies were performed either by the host chapter or by Grand Officers. Brothers of Theta Delta skillfully performed by initiation of the founding member of our new Colony at UNC-Wilmington, while Grand Officers handled all other fraternity ceremonies.

What Chi Phi Congress would be complete without its social aspects which were supported by the Florida Alumni Association to the same generous extent which they back the four active Florida chapters. Although rain forced several scheduled events inside, there were enough clear moments to put 8, 12 and 14 floor patio balconies to use overtime.

The 1977 Congress was brought to a conclusion with a branch following the Sunday morning session. The final event was greeted with the return of Florida sunshine which a number of delegates found too hard to resist. Many stayed over an additional day using part of their extra time to check out some jai-alai competition or the nearest dog track. When it was all over, there could be no doubt that the weather had not prevented this from becoming one of our really outstanding Congress gatherings.
